

Computer Option Available for Grade 10, 11, and 12

Saskatoon Catholic School Division Cyber School is willing to offer Christian Ethics 10, 20, and 30 online to any secondary student in the province of Saskatchewan. As part of their role in evangelization the Saskatoon Catholic Cyber School is offering these courses at no charge. (All other high school cyber courses are \$500.00 to students who are not enrolled in the Saskatoon Catholic School Division). The Christian Ethics courses are also available to students 17-22 years of age not enrolled in school who wish to enrich their faith.

The Catechetics Office of the Diocese of Prince Albert encourages secondary students of the Diocese, who are not attending Catholic high schools to enrich their faith by enrolling in Christian Ethics Online from Saskatoon Catholic Cyber School. The advantage to taking Christian Ethics Online include:

- a. You receive provincial credit from Sask Learning
- b. You can take the course from any where you have internet access
- c. You can take the course on your own time
- d. You receive feedback and instruction from highly trained cyber teachers
- e. You interact with students from across the province
- f. You can interact with the Cyber School Chaplain
- g. You learn new computer skills
- h. You learn more about your Christian faith.
- i. You come closer to Jesus

What is It??.....

An at-home study of the Catholic faith designed for Canadian families with the same content as the school and parish editions; administered by the Roman Catholic Diocese of Prince Albert Catechetics Office.



Born of the Spirit Series is a Canadian program, which covers Years 1 through 8. High School students, Grades 10-12, are encouraged to enroll in the Saskatoon

Catholic Christian Ethics Online Computer Courses (see back panel for more information). These flexible faith initiation resources can be followed through correspondence or in your home parish setting.



In order for children to develop an in-depth, well-rounded grounding in our Catholic faith, it is important for them to be enrolled in a catechetical program.

This program is being offered to families whose children are attending a public school and who do not have access or are unable to attend a parish catechetical program.

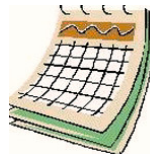
How is a catechetical program different from sacramental preparation?

Sacramental Preparation for First Reconciliation, Confirmation and First Eucharist are just that, preparation for the reception of the sacraments. Catechetical education is formation in the faith. In other words, the immediate preparation for the sacraments prepares one to celebrate the sacrament; it does not provide the deeper faith formation offered in a year long process that takes you through the liturgical seasons of the Church year.

For Whom is it Most Suitable?

Anyone from Years 1 - 8 who does not attend a Catholic school, does not have the opportunity or cannot follow a program offered by their parish.

How Long is It?



September through May. Years 1 - 8 consist of 20- 22 themes each.

When is Best Time to Enroll?

Preferred time is August to early September. In this way, packages can be ordered and the program can be started by October.

What is the Cost?

There is a cost recovery charge for materials. Prices are in accordance with National Office price listings. Registration fee, postage and handling are subject to the number of children in the family. See enrollment form for fee information.

Conditions for Advancement

To advance a student must complete all the themes in the year. A Certificate of Advancement will be presented upon completion.
