Dear Fathers, Sisters, Parish Administrators and all the Faithful of the Diocese of Prince Albert,

The following is a list of amendments to the Clergy and Diocesan Appointments of the May 3, 2011 letter for the 2011/2012 year. These changes will take effect **August 1st**, 2011:

- **Fr. Maurice Fiolleau** as Vicar General will be moving to a full time position at the Chancery Office. He will celebrate Saturday Mass at Columbian Centre and Sunday Mass at Herb Bassett in Prince Albert and assist Fr. Travis Myrheim at the Diocesan Discernment House. Also, he will oversee the Marriage Preparation Teams for the Diocese of Prince Albert and be available for replacing in the different parishes when possible. On a temporary basis, he will be Director of Adult Faith and Director of Liturgy for the Diocese.
- **Fr. Val Besas** will continue to be pastor of St. Joseph Calasanctius in North Battleford and provide ministry to the schools of École Monseigneur Blaise Morand and Holy Family; to the care home of River Heights Lodge and co-minister to the High School of John Paul II Collegiate.
- **Fr. Anthony Afangide, MSP** will be pastor of St. Vital in Battleford and provide ministry and pastoral duties to St. Vital Catholic School, the care home of Battlefords District Care Centre and co-minister to the High School of John Paul II Collegiate. He will also be pastor of the communities in Delmas, Vawn, and Meota.
- **Fr. Frederick Akah, MSP** will be pastor of the communities in Cutknife, Marsden/Neilburg, Lashburn, Maidstone, Sweetgrass, and Poundmaker.
- **Fr. Tuan Doan** will continue to be pastor of St. Mark Parish in Prince Albert and provide ministry and pastoral duties to St. John Community School. He **will continue** to be part-time Chaplain at the Victoria Hospital. He will also provide pastoral care visits and celebrate Mass for Mont St Joseph on Thursdays and Sundays.
- **Fr. Alberto Dela Pena** has resigned as Director of Liturgy for the Diocese. He will continue to provide ministry to the community of Our Lady of Consolation of Melfort.

Studies and other changes:

- **Fr. Hervé Vallée** for health reasons will no longer be providing replacement services for the clergy and parishes outside of the city of Prince Albert. We are very grateful to him for the many services he provides to the Diocese and its people.
- **Michael Averyt**, Director of Adult Faith Education for the Diocese will be a resident of St. Joseph Seminary this coming year to complete his studies for the priesthood and also for a time of discernment.

I wish to thank all the priests who have generously accepted these amendments of appointments.
May God bless and guide them in their new assignments!
