

# Diocese of Prince Albert Student Art/Poster Contest

Summer 2022, will mark the next World Youth Day in Lisbon, Portugal. In preparation for this wonderful event the Diocese of Prince Albert's Vocation Commission is bringing awareness through a student art/poster contest. The purpose of this contest is to invite students to create art that promotes both World Youth Day 2022 and God's call to stand up and act. The invitation to participate is open to students from Kindergarten to grade 12.

The three categories for the art/poster competition are

K-5, Gr 6-9, Gr 10-12.

## Regulations

- Entry deadline is April 24, 2020. Entries are to be sent to the Diocesan Office
- Entries must have the theme for the World Youth Day 2022; "Mary arose and left with haste" Luke 1:38
- Entries are to be no smaller than a regular sized sheet of paper (8.5 x 11) and no larger than 40cm by 50cm.
- Entries are to be two dimensional in traditional art media (pen and ink, crayon, oil, watercolour, collage, fabric art, etc). No digital art, photography or three dimensional art.
- Winning submission will be displayed in the Prince Albert Catholic Churches for a short period of time. If the student wishes, the art piece may be picked up from the Diocesan Office after June 1st. The pieces will not be mailed or sent back to the applicant.
- To enter, complete the entry form and include with the art piece.

## Prizes:

- Once judged, the winning submission will receive:
  - o First place
    - Elementary: \$50 gift certificate to Cineplex Theatre
    - Middle School (grade 6-9): \$50 gift certificate to Cineplex Theatre
    - High School: \$50 gift certificate to Cineplex Theatre
  - o Second place
    - Elementary: \$25 gift certificate to Cineplex Theatre
    - Middle School (grade 6-9): \$25 gift certificate to Cineplex Theatre
    - High School: \$25 gift certificate to Cineplex Theatre

## Guiding Questions

Guiding Questions are meant to serve as a means to encourage creative development

1. Mary's vocation was to be the mother of Jesus. Being married and being parents can be a difficult vocation. Draw what you think are the challenges or blessings of the Vocation of Marriage
2. It is very challenging to do what God asks us to do. What are some challenges that you have at school or home? How can God help you with those challenges?
3. God calls people "Set out and go with haste" to Marriage, the Priesthood, the Religious Life, or the single life. Who is someone whom you believe is following God's voice?
