PASTORAL LETTER ON THE USE OF SOCIAL MEDIA - New!

With the approval of the Permanent Council, the CCCB Episcopal Commission for Justice and Peace has today released its Pastoral Letter on the use of social media titled: "*Let Your Speech Always Be Gracious."* The release is timed with the liturgical memorial of Saint Francis de Sales, who was known for his graciousness in speech and who is invoked as a patron saint of writers and publishers.

The Pastoral Letter responds to the priority assigned to the Episcopal Commission for Justice and Peace by the Permanent Council in 2019.





On 10 January 2024, the Vatican published Pope Francis' <u>message</u> for the 32nd World Day of the Sick, celebrated each year on February 11. The Holy Father's message for this year is entitled: **"It is not good that man should be alone". Healing the Sick by Healing Relationships.**

Echoing the Holy Father's message, the Canadian Conference of Catholic Bishops (CCCB) renews its commitment to prayer and accompaniment of the sick. Pope Francis reminds us of the fundamental importance of human relationships in the process of healing and comforting the sick.

The CCCB Office for Family and Life has compiled and developed some resources to help promote World Day of the Sick 2024. 
