11km to St. Laurent Shrine

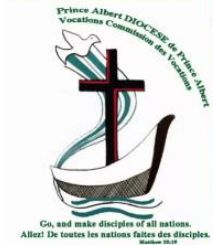


