Pray for peace in Ukraine

ADVOCACY RALLY MINORITY DAY - New!

Pakistan was created on 14 August 1947, the founding father Mohammad Ali Jinnah invited the religious minorities, especially Christians to vote for the creation of Pakistan. On 11 August 1947, while speaking to the Constituent Assembly of Pakistan, Mr. Jinnah promised an inclusive & impartial government, religious freedom and equality for all of the Christians, Hindu and Sikhs who voted and remained in Pakistan. The Punjab province of Pakistan was accepted as a part of Pakistan by a decisive vote of a Christian Leader SP Singh. However, with the passage of time the promises made by Mr Jinnah went with the winds and the status of religious minorities deteriorated with each passing day, especially from the Zia Ul Haq regime onwards.

In relevance to the above, Christian Leader Martyr Shahbaz Bhatti during his tenure as Federal Minister for Minorities advocated and successfully got declared 11th August 2009 as National Minority Day by the government of Pakistan to acknowledge the contribution of religious minorities and resolve to address their plight.

Every year, Minorities Alliance Pakistan (MAP) commemorates National Minority Day on August 11 and organizes a public rally to highlight the legal and social discrimination of minorities and demand equal rights as citizens. Last Friday, MAP launched a peaceful public rally in Islamabad to advocate on behalf of the persecuted religious minorities. The aim of the Rally was to highlight the discriminatory laws against religious minorities, Stop misuse of blasphemy laws, Stop forced conversion, rape, abduction and forced marriage of underage Christian girls, implementation of 5% quota passed by the government and not implemented.

However, Islamabad police Baton Charge the peaceful rally. In response, the MAP workers in their defense also backlashed similarly. Many MAP workers got injured and the policeman also got injured. Watch some photos on social media


