Two Years of Learning and Exploring for Those Seeking a Spirituality for their Wisdom Years
February 2024 - November 2025

Growing in Wisdom: Seeking Deeper Generativity is an ecumenical program, rooted in the Forest Dwelling Program created by Fr. Ron Rolheiser OMI, grounded in the mystical Christian Tradition, open to learning from other interfaith and spiritual traditions, and designed for those seeking to engage in their maturing years with wisdom and grace. It is a program that welcomes participants who have the time, interest, and energy to engage in a dynamic two-year adventure of learning and exploration. This is a time in which we can begin to look back on the life we have lived and find openness to new or previously undeveloped inner vistas. It is a time to begin to come to terms with our own mortality and the grace we find in facing this part of our lives with wisdom and gratitude. This two-year program, offered on zoom to welcome people from across Canada and beyond, is a dynamic interplay between and among each participant, the Growing in Wisdom Community, and Divine Mystery, assisting in the inner transformation of participants as the journey unfolds. Growing in Wisdom: Seeking Deeper Generativity invites you to explore how you might commit yourself to giving both your life and your death to the world, in a way in which both are the ultimate gift and blessing that you give to others. • SOUL LISTENING: A DAY OF LEARNING AND RENEWAL - Friday February 2, 9:00 a.m. - 4:00 p.m. Offered in-person at Queen's House, and on zoom. Facilitator: Julie Bergen. Join other caregivers as we step away for a day to focus on listening to ourselves and others. We will learn active listening skills and contemplate how listening becomes soul listening. We will practice this together as we in turn offer a listening presence and receive the gift of soul listening. This inter-faith program is for: anyone seeking to further develop their supportive presence with those they encounter; those who wish to volunteer in their faith-group or in the wider community; those already volunteering in their faith-group or in the wider community; those who are caregivers within their own families or circle of friends. This interactive training will provide skills, discussion, and small-group interaction as we practice active listening, attend to feelings, and focus on providing a compassionate presence to others.

- <u>TAIZÉ PRAYER</u> Second Wednesday of the month: **February 14, 7:00 8:00 p.m.** (Taizé will not be offered in December). Members of our L'Arche Community provide the leadership for the Taizé Prayer Service. Meditative singing is one of the most essential elements of worship in Taizé. Short songs, repeating again and again, give it a meditative character. No registration come when you can.
- <u>T'AI CHI CHIH: A MINDFULNESS MOVING MEDITATION</u> Saturday February 17, 1:00 4:00 p.m. Facilitator: Donna Aldous. T'ai Chi Chih is a mindfulness moving meditation. The set of 19 movements and one pose is soft, flowing and easy to learn. Benefits may include peace of mind, improved health and simply, joy. TCC practice allows the essential energy, or Chi, that moves within us all to circulate and balance. That in turn improves our health and sense of well-being. TCC is not a martial art it is completely non-violent. T'ai Chi Chih does not require a particular level of physical fitness or coordination. The very old and very young alike can learn it. • JESUS SAID TO THEM, 'FOLLOW ME.' THE WAY OF JESUS AND HOW HE EMPOWERS PEOPLE TO FOLLOW IT - Five Wednesdays, February 21 to March 20, 2:00 - 4:00 p.m. CST. Classes offered at Queen's House and on Zoom. Instructor: Don Schweitzer, PhD. These five sessions will examine the way of Jesus and how he empowers people to follow him. It will first look at the notion of "following Jesus," what the parameters and principles of this are, and what this might mean in Canada today. It will look at how Jesus empowers and guides people to follow him through examining traditional theories of atonement.

February 21: The Way of Jesus - This session looks at the ethical teaching, examples, and practices of Jesus. It moves back and forth between the gospels and the present, looking at ways in which people have tried to follow Jesus then, now, and in between.

February 28: The Moral Influence Theory of Atonement - This session begins by looking at what atonement means, and then examines the moral influence theory of atonement and its strengths and weaknesses. It looks at the type of sin or evil that the moral influence theory of atonement addresses, where it locates this, how it addresses it. **March 6:** Jesus as a Source of Ultimate Hope - This session examines the Christus Victor theory of atonement. It looks at its origins, the images used to express it, the kind of sin or evil it addresses, and who tends to use it. It examines the danger of dualism as a weakness of this theory, and the hope it inspires as one of its strengths. **March 13:** Substitutionary Atonement - Substitutionary atonement is what many people think of when they hear the word 'atonement.' This understanding of Jesus' saving significance has been widely criticized in recent decades. This session will examine its origins, its understanding of how Jesus saves, and how theologians have tried to rethink this theory of atonement in spatial terms.

March 20: Jesus as the Centre of History - This session looks at how Jesus gives people orientation in life. It examines how this orientation is developed, why people might need this. It will also examine the Franciscan innovation in Christology, the idea that creation is oriented to the coming of Jesus, and some implications of this. Registration deadline: February 19
