

CALLED AND GIFTED INTRODUCTORY WORKSHOP - New!

THE CALLED & GIFTED INTRODUCTORY WORKSHOP

... is the first of three steps in the C&G Discernment Process. During this fivesession workshop, you will learn the Church's ancient teaching on charisms, the steps for discerning your God-given charisms, and how discerning your charisms can change your life, parish, and community.

This year, during the Lenten Season, there will be four opportunities to take step one of the Called & Gifted Discernment Process. Participants are required to purchase the Called & Gifted Discernment Process resource book. The cost is \$60 plus \$5 for mailing. For those interested in taking Step One of the C&G Discernment Process, the fivesession Introductory Workshop will be offered four times during Lent, twice on Zoom and twice in person, by the Diocesan Called & Gifted Team.

PASTORAL LETTER ON THE USE OF SOCIAL MEDIA

With the approval of the Permanent Council, the CCCB Episcopal Commission for Justice and Peace has today released its Pastoral Letter on the use of social media titled: "*Let Your Speech Always Be Gracious."* The release is timed with the liturgical memorial of Saint Francis de Sales, who was known for his graciousness in speech and who is invoked as a patron saint of writers and publishers.

The Pastoral Letter responds to the priority assigned to the Episcopal Commission for Justice and Peace by the Permanent Council in 2019.

STAND FOR THE LAND - New!

Before the imminent launch of our next Share Lent campaign, I would like to share a final update on our <u>Stand for the Land</u> campaign, which will soon draw to a close.

Our program officer Mary Durran has filed a <u>field report from Honduras</u>, from the Guapinol community that the campaign is supporting.

The licence of the mine that has been polluting their rivers has expired, but its powerful owners are lobbying to have it renewed for 30 years. The community, which has opposed the mine repeatedly, unanimously and on pain of imprisonment and death, is now mobilizing to block the renewal of its permit.

They have reiterated their appreciation of Canadians' efforts to amplify their voices, which are still going largely unheard. That is why we need more and more people to <u>sign our</u> <u>campaign letter</u> before it is delivered to the Honduran ambassador to Canada next month. We are still some ways short of our target of 32,000 signatures, and I am hoping you can help us meet it!

Please do all you can to **give this campaign one last big push** in your parish bulletins, on your website and through your social media channels.


