We have moved into the listening phase of the Synodal Process! Parishes have begun group sessions and other consultations. The updated time frame for the listening phase is January – End of March 2022. The Diocese will also be hosting three Synodal gatherings to look at specific topics of interest (Christian Unity, Celebration, and Missionary Disciples)

Before we gather on March 23rd, please take the time to consider the following questions prayerfully.

Since we are all missionary disciples, how is every baptized person called to participate in the Church's mission? What hinders the baptized from being active in the mission? What areas of the mission are we neglecting? How does the community support its members who serve society in various ways (social and political involvement, scientific research, education, promoting social justice, protecting human rights, caring for the environment, etc.)? ADULT FAITH:

Journey through Lent Virtual Opportunities for Adults and Families

Adults



This year's Virtual Lenten Bible Study will focus on the Passion reading from Palm Sunday, Apr 10, 2022 (Luke 22.14-23.56). The reading will be reflected on over the six Thursdays from Mar 3 until Apr 7.

The evening will begin with Lectio Divina, followed by small group sharing on the reading. These are stand-alone sessions, so if you cannot attend them all but would like to attend a few of them, that would be fine.

Lectio Divina (Latin for "Divine Reading") is a traditional monastic practise of reading Scripture to promote communion with God and increase knowledge of God's word. The chosen reading is listened to four times from four different stances: Lectio (Read), Meditatio (Reflect - Think), Oratio (Respond - Pray), and Contemplatio (Rest - Remain in God's presence).



Family Faith Formation at Home – Video's will appear on Facebook; Sundays beginning Feb 27 and will be posted to the Office of Evangelization and Catechesis page on Mondays

A ten-part video series based on the book, *Benjamin's Box*, follows Jesus' way of the cross through a little boy's eyes. Each clip in this series, created by local catechists, offers a 15–30-minute session, which contains a short reading from the story *Benjamin's Box* followed by a Scripture reading, a craft, a challenge, and a prayer. The series can be viewed on Sundays beginning Feb 27 and concluding during the Easter weekend on the [RC Diocese of Prince Albert: Evangelization and Catechesis Facebook page](#) and later on Mondays on the [Evangelization and Catechesis webpage on the RC Diocese of PA website](#). By the end of the series, children with their families will have heard the Easter story and collected items symbolizing key moments of Jesus' experience during his last days:

- His triumphant entry into Jerusalem on a donkey
- The last supper
- Jesus' prayer in the Garden of Gethsemane
- Jesus' torture and crucifixion
- The Resurrection on Easter morning.

As you know, Human Trafficking continues to be a growing problem in the world and in Canada. My name is Susan Patterson and I have spent the last 10 years solely focused on empowering and equipping churches in the fight against human trafficking, by showing them exactly how churches can do their part. I am a national leader in the fight against human trafficking and am also a member of CCOAHT (Coalition of Catholic Organizations Against Human Trafficking) that is hosted by the US Conference of Catholic bishops. CCOAHT has promoted some of our resources.

The ministry I direct, Through God's Grace, teaches and connects churches by hosting discussion groups with experts, providing powerful educational events and video trainings at our You Tube channel and offering the book "How You Can Fight Human Trafficking, Over 100 Ways to Make a Difference" that is offered for free 4 times a year as an e-book download.
