### **Diocesan Synod Wrap-Up! What have we heard?**

The Diocesan Synod Wrap-Up will be taking place on June 4 from 10:00 a.m. to 1:30 p.m. at St. Joseph parish in Prince Albert...260 - 25 St E, Prince Albert, SK. The coffee will be on at 9:30 a.m., so plan to come early and visit with others from across the Diocese.

An option to attend the Wrap-Up virtually is also being offered if attending in person for any reason is not possible.

The primary focus of the Wrap-Up is the sharing of the Diocesan Synod report before it is sent on to the Western region, where it will be synthesized with the reports from the other Western Dioceses. There will also be an opportunity at the event for small group conversations about what we have heard and how the results of this listening process are calling us to journey forward as the Diocese. The Wrap-Up will conclude with a Eucharistic celebration, followed by lunch.

If your parish did not have a listening session or you did not take part in a listening session, your presence at this Wrap-Up is still very important. The Synod Planning Committee hopes that you will take this next opportunity to participate as the Synod results will impact our diocesan journey in the future.

However you plan to attend, you will need to register. Parishes are being asked to register attendees as a group, though there is also an option to register as an individual if registering with your parish is not possible. ## Prison Visitation



Our prison visitation program, Person to Person, has been very limited during the past two years of the pandemic.

I have been privileged to be asked by Sask Pen to provide P2P in the Structured Interventions Unit of Maximum Security in the last year. I spend time every week visiting with men who live in one of the most isolated places in society.

This program receives many requests throughout the year from inmates wanting to participate. Some of the reasons the inmates give for wanting to get involved are:

- Looking for community support upon reintegration;
- Feeling isolated and lonely;
- Wanting a friend

From an inmate at Sask Pen:

*"Without the volunteers all of us who are involved on the inside would lose our only chance to build on how we interact in a social setting."*

## Offender Reintegration



We have some bad news and some good news. As you may have known, our CoSA funding stream from the federal government ended on March 31, 2022. We have been working for a couple of years to renew this funding or secure fresh resources. After much advocacy, nationally and locally right here in the Prince Albert region; on April 7, the national budget held no sources of funding for CoSA.

However, we are very thankful to announce that we have received a grant from **The Law Foundation of Saskatchewan** to continue the programming for the next year!

Thank you to local MPs Randy Hoback and Gary Vidal as well as the RCMP and Prince Albert Police and many more for their support of this valuable initiative.

## Community Engagement



We are happy to announce that the Dad HERO programming from Canadian Families and Corrections Network will be continuing for 2022-23. The renewed grant allows us to offer parenting courses to fathers serving time at the Sask Pen. They receive the supports they need to stay connected to their kids which leads to better reintegration outcomes.

Dad Hero helps provide resources for these men on how they could better connect to their children while in prison and upon release.

Pastor Seth has already been teaching this course since last fall with some interruptions due to Covid lockdowns.

### **OUR LADY OF CAPE**

Canada was Consecrated to the Immaculate Heart of Mary in Ottawa in 1947. This year, we celebrate the 75<sup>th</sup> Anniversary of this event. The Marian Statue that was used at the time was from Canada's National Marian Shrine located at Cap de la Madeleine near Trois Rivières, Quebec. The original statue is known as Our Lady of the Cape. As a result, the Marian Devotional Movement is visiting various dioceses in Canada in 2022 as it spearheads pilgrim statue tours of Our Lady of the Cape to provide opportunities for Canadians to venerate Canada's National Madonna, to promote consecration to the Immaculate Heart of Mary and to promote enrollment in the Confraternity of the Most Holy Rosary.
