



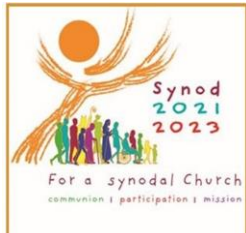

We have moved into the listening phase of the Synodal Process! Parishes have begun group sessions and other consultations. The updated time frame for the listening phase is January – End of March 2022. The Diocese will also be hosting three Synodal gatherings to look at specific topics of interest (Christian Unity, Celebration, and Missionary Disciples) and hosting two general forums on the main Synod questions. 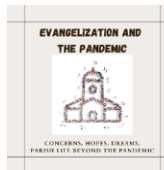
PARTNERING WITH PARENTS: BUILD FAITH-FILLED CATHOLIC FAMILIES

Houses for Haiti

Thank you for your unstinting response to the Haitian earthquake of August 14, 2021. **You contributed over \$620,000!**

With the distribution of emergency aid now concluded, Development and Peace is allocating \$300,000 to the *Institut de Technologie et d'Animation* (ITECA) for longer-term recovery efforts. These will include restoring agriculture and **building cyclone - and earthquake-resistant houses** in Cavaillon, where ITECA has a [robust house-building record](#).

Although over 3,000 houses were destroyed in Cavaillon, budgetary constraints, rising costs and a commitment to quality will limit ITECA to building only 25 houses for now, at a cost of about \$15,200 each.

With more support, ITECA could build more houses and offer even more Haitian families a more secure future.

HUMAN TRAFFICKING

As you know, Human Trafficking continues to be a growing problem in the world and in Canada. My name is Susan Patterson and I have spent the last 10 years solely focused on empowering and equipping churches in the fight against human trafficking, by showing them exactly how churches can do their part. I am a national leader in the fight against human trafficking and am also a member of CCOAHT (Coalition of Catholic Organizations Against Human Trafficking) that is hosted by the US Conference of Catholic bishops. CCOAHT has promoted some of our resources.

The ministry I direct, Through God's Grace, teaches and connects churches by hosting discussion groups with experts, providing powerful educational events and video trainings at our You Tube channel and offering the book "How You Can Fight Human Trafficking, Over 100 Ways to Make a Difference" that is offered for free 4 times a year as an e-book download.

Calming the Storm for Teens

Calming The Storm For Teens is offered over 3 weeks. It is an anger management program specifically for 13 to 18 year olds. The program is designed to improve self-esteem and to learn anger management and effective communication skills.

The program teaches participants to cope with anger by answering questions such as:

- What is anger?
- How does anger affect my body and my health?
- How do I show anger?
- Where is my anger coming from?
- When does anger become a problem?
- How can I manage anger?
- What is forgiveness?

Calming the Storm for Teen will run:

Wed – Feb. 2, 9 and 16 – 5:15 to 7:15

Supper is provided and transportation is provided as needed.

There is a \$25 fee.

Riding the Wave

This program is for children 6 to 12 and their parents/guardians. It is for children recovering from violence or trauma.

Riding the Wave uses a variety of weekly activities which are designed to improve self-esteem, communication skills problem solving by using and will learn ways of dealing with violence and trauma.

Riding the Wave will run:

Sat. and Sun., Feb. 12 and 13 from 9am to 12 noon

Transportation is provided as needed.
